

2019 Equine Upper Airway Symposium

Surgical Residents and Program Directors,

This is a reminder that registration is open for the Equine Upper Airway Symposium to be held September 19-22, 2019 at Rood & Riddle Equine Hospital in Lexington, KY.

This 3½-day symposium, sponsored in part by Rood & Riddle Equine Hospital, Optomed and the American College of Veterinary Surgeons (ACVS) Foundation, offers lectures and laboratories designed to present in depth, current information regarding pathophysiology, diagnosis, treatment, and prognosis for upper airway (UA) conditions in the horse. The target participants for the meeting are veterinarians in resident training programs and clinicians who have not had the desired exposure to UA conditions in the horse. The number of participants will be limited to 28, dictated by available laboratory space.

This program has been submitted for 26.5 hours of continuing education credits in jurisdictions that recognize AAVSB RACE approval; however, participants should be aware that some boards have limitations on the number of hours accepted in certain categories and/or restrictions on certain methods of delivery of continuing education. Symposium laboratories will cover anatomy of the larynx, laryngeal ultrasound, remote dynamic endoscopy, and sinoscopy, frontonasal flap, tie forward, tie-back, arytenoidectomy, and laser ventriculocordectomy surgical procedures.
