

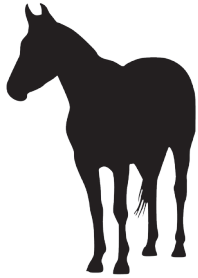

Intra Operative Imaging Guided Techniques

Wednesday, 3 July 2019, 09:00-16:45

Title: Large Animal Surgery

Course type: Theory and case discussion

Description: This will be a one-day meeting comprising lectures and case base discussions. Held in a forum format where delegates will be encouraged to participate, this workshop aims to aid surgeons in the use of different imaging techniques to best overcome some of the challenges met in equine surgery. There will be specific cases discussed as well as pitfalls to be avoided.

This workshop will include: lecture based discussions on the use of intraoperative CT, ultrasound, fluoroscopy and radiology to aid the surgeon in intraoperative decisions.

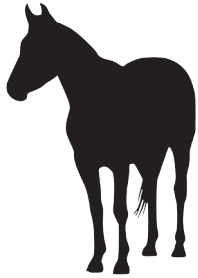
