


AO VET Seminar—Common complications in fracture repair in large animals

Seminar description

Complications are a reality of fracture repair and arthrodesis in horses. Many can be avoided or minimized by being aware of biomechanics and predisposing factors. Others are unavoidable, but their resolution may be aided by early diagnosis and appropriate treatment. Some of the key points that will be touched are Intra and Postoperative complications of Lag screw fixation and of plate fixation and how to prevent infection in fracture repair.

The target is surgeons comfortable taking over decision-making responsibility for the treatment of complex injuries (ideally those that have taken an Advanced AO VET course already).
