
## Magnifying loupes surgical skills lab



#### Wednesday, 6 July 2022, 08:30 - 17:45 REELANCE **Sponsored by Freelance Surgical and Medtronic** Small Animal **Species: Course type:** Full day theory and practical session **Course description:** This is the **second edition** of the "Microsurgical Techniques" course at the ECVS meeting. The course is designed to give delegates a basic understanding and experience with general microsurgical techniques. This course will be divided into a theoretical and a practical session using various low-fidelity models and fresh cadaveric tissues. This year, the course will take place at the University of Porto. The theoretical session will review common indications for microsurgery in veterinary patients, use of magnification, basic instrumentation, ergonomy, and microsurgical suturing techniques. **The practical session** will allow delegates to practice several techniques including simple linear suturing, end-to-end anastomosis, and endto-side anastomosis using low-fidelity models, fresh cadaveric tissue and micro-suture material. All practical exercises will be performed using magnifying surgical loupes. Delegates are welcome to bring their own loupes, otherwise surgical loupes (3x magnification) will be provided. By the end of the course, each delegate will have had the opportunity to: • Experience the benefits of utilizing loupes for magnification Practice basic surgical techniques of microsurgery Simulate challenging clinical cases that require microsurgical skill such as ureteral obstruction, common bile duct rupture, vascular anastomosis, and nerve repair using representative tissues Feedback from delegates (previous edition): "The course was a great introduction to microsurgery.
