

Residency in Equine Surgery Bosdreef Belgium

Equine Hospital De Bosdreef, located in Moerbeke-Waas, Belgium, one of the leading equine referral hospitals in Europe, is accepting applicants for a three-year ECVS approved residency programme in Equine Surgery. The successful candidate will be expected to fulfil credentials within this three-year period and be eligible to sit the ECVS board examinations.

The successful candidate will be supervised by 3 ECVS board certified surgeons and will work closely with one ECEIM and one Assoc. (LA) ECVDI diplomate, along further clinicians, interns and technical staff. The hospital has recently relocated to a state of the art building, with fixed and mobile DR system (100kW generator), 2 ESAOTE ultrasound machines, standing MRI, gamma scintigraphy and a Qualisys motion sensor system. A CT system for both standing and GA scanning is currently in development. The hospital performs approximately 800 surgical procedures a year, along with more than 2,500 orthopaedic examinations, 800 internal medicine cases, 450 MRI scans and 250 gamma-scintigraphy scans.

Applicants must be qualified veterinary surgeons (DVM or equivalent) who have a minimum of 1-2 years experience in equine and or mixed practice. Ideally applicants should also have completed an equine internship, but this is not essential. A hard work ethic, motivation to succeed and a good sense of humour are a must. The successful applicant will participate in provision of surgical and orthopaedic services as well as in the out of hours rota. Individual case responsibility will be achieved with time.

Spoken and written English is essential, with Dutch and French a big advantage.

Potential applicants are strongly recommended to visit the hospital prior to submitting an application.
