Small Animal Surgery Residency Winchester, UK

Anderson Moores Veterinary Specialists invite applications for an ECVS-approved Standard Veterinary Surgery Residency Programme, to commence the 12th August 2019.

Anderson Moores Veterinary Specialists is a busy multi-disciplinary private small animal referral practice located within the beautiful Hampshire countryside. The hospital is close to the historic city of Winchester (which is 1 hour from London by train) and is within easy reach of the New Forest and South Downs national parks and the Solent (for sailing). Southampton airport, an international airport serving many European destinations, is 20 minutes away.

You will join a team of 40 referral clinicians, 6 of whom are ECVS Diplomates. You will partake in the small animal surgery referral service including contributing to the weekend emergency service and you will be encouraged to partake in clinical research projects. You must have excellent English language skills, be registered with the Royal College of Veterinary Surgeons (MRCVS) or be eligible to register, be eligible to work in the UK and you must have a minimum of two years of clinical experience since graduation. Ideally candidates will have completed a rotating internship in a multidisciplinary referral centre as well as having experience of first-opinion small animal practice. Consideration will be given to candidates who have not completed an internship if they can demonstrate a sufficient level of postgraduate clinical experience.

The position is for three years and will satisfy ECVS Standard Veterinary Surgery Residency requirements. Salary will be £30,000 per annum with additional benefits to include an optional pension scheme and healthcare insurance. There will be 4 weeks paid holiday each year in addition to bank holidays and funds available for external CPD.

Applications should include a current curriculum vitae, a photograph (so that we can remember past and future visitors) and a hand-written letter of intent explaining why you would make a good candidate.
