

The RCVS accredited veterinary hospital is led by an internationally recognised specialist in equine surgery, with an experienced team of Hospital Vets and Nurses to support. We have extensive facilities with a wide range of diagnostic, therapeutic & surgical equipment (including stabling for up to 19 horses). We offer standing and general anaesthetic surgery, arthroscopy, laparoscopy, flexible endoscopic surgery, including diode laser and Ligasure electrosurgery. There is an Equinosis lameness locator and VideoMed overground endoscope available. There are hard and soft lunging areas and a manège for ridden examination. We also provide our own OOH service. There would be opportunity for a transition period, depending on experience, but the rota would be expected to be 1 in 4 for weekends and 1 in 3 weekdays out of hours.

Although we are open to all experience levels, within this role we are excited to be able to offer hands on mentorship to be able to help you achieve the next level in your career. It would be advantageous if you had an interest in equine orthopaedics, but there is scope to mould and build up your own caseload dependent on your surgical interests.

Based in the traditional Leicestershire village of Sileby, the practice is either a 20-minute drive or 15-minute train from the centre of Leicester. You will also have easy access to Loughborough and Nottingham.
